1. Введение

(slide 1) Good afternoon, dear guests. Our event is dedicated to one of the most beautiful and merriest holidays - Christmas. It is one of the most important, significant, and beloved holidays of the year. This is especially true for the English. Not a single holiday, even the New Year, can compare with Christmas in terms of the scale of preparation and celebration. As with no other holiday, they begin to prepare for Christmas in advance. (ПРИЛОЖЕНИЕ 1)

(slide 2) Who knows what does the word 'Christmas' mean? The word Christmas is taken from 'Christ's Mass'. Christmas is a holiday dedicated to the birth of Jesus Christ.

Let's learn a bit more about this holiday by watching the video of its history.

(VIDEO 1 - History)

(slide 3) The day before Christmas is called Christmas Eve and the night is Holy. On Christmas Eve, young schoolchildren participate in performances dedicated to the birth of Christ. They act out scenes from biblical life, where the main characters are Mary, Joseph, infant Jesus Christ, shepherds and Magi who came to congratulate and present their gifts to the newborn baby Jesus. (slide 4) Children with great desire and pleasure take part in productions that usually take place at churches. Such performances are called Nativity play. (slide 5) A tradition that continues, especially in the country, is that of Carol-singing, when groups of people stand in the street, or go from door to door, singing carols and collecting for a charity.

And now we suggest you to watch a video with a Carol song.

(VIDEO 2 – Carols)(slide 6) Traditionally for Christmas has become the song "Jingle bells". Let's continue our holiday with this song.

(VIDEO 3 – Jingle bells), (звучит песня «Jingle Bells»)

There is no Christmas celebration for every English man and woman without monarchy's speech. Unfortunately, not long ago the queen Elizabeth II died, but her performances were always so memorable, remarkable and with a great dignity. We suggest you to watch one of her speeches.

(VIDEO 4 - Обращение королевы)

2. Основная часть

(slide 7) Today we will learn a lot about Christmas. And you will help us to do it. That's why we have two teams today. One team knows all about Christmas characters and the other – about Christmas decorations and dishes.

So, our first group – the experts at Christmas characters.

Our next group - the experts at Christmas decorations and dishes.

You have learned a lot of vocabulary connected to Christmas. Let's start our competition. (Записать на доске названия команд). Your first task will be to revise as many words as you can. (slides 8-38, ПРИЛОЖЕНИЕ 2)

There is a good tradition in Great Britain to congratulate relatives, friends and colleagues on Christmas. People usually buy a lot of various Christmas cards with its symbols. And now you have a chance to congratulate each other too. Our second task is "Christmas card". You must write congratulations to each other from 10 words minimum. (Студентам раздаются чистые листы, конверты, ножницы, клей. Задача — написать поздравление, разрезать его на слова, положить в конверт и отправить другой команде. После получения письма необходимо собрать первоначальное послание, наклеив слова на листе бумаги).

Another famous tradition for Christmas is presenting gifts, so your next task is to watch a video from one of the most well-known sitcoms "Friends" about Christmas presents and answer the questions (Video "Friends", ПРИЛОЖЕНИЕ 3). (Студенты смотрят отрывок из известного ситкома «Друзья» и после отвечают на вопросы).

There is another Christmas tradition – to organize family games, quizzes, riddles and so on. We suggest you to take part in a such funny tradition. You will get a list of Christmas ABC and guess coded words. (Студенты получают листы с Рождественским алфавитом и загадками, которые необходимо отгадать, **ПРИЛОЖЕНИЕ 4**)

We have learned a lot of new Christmas words today. And let's make a revision of our today's competition. Our last task to guess English Christmas riddles. (Студентам выдаются листы с загадками, которые необходимо разгадать, ПРИЛОЖЕНИЕ 5)

Let's sum up our competition, count the points and find out the winner.
